A 65 caterpillar hatches out of the egg. It grows 74 quickly, getting bigger and bigger. Then it is ready 85 to form a chrysalis. It stays in its chrysalis until it 95 is ready to hatch, and then out comes an adult 102 butterfly. Female butterflies lay eggs, and the 106 entire cycle repeats itself!

Spring Weather

Spring is one of the four seasons. It starts at Iq the end of March, and lasts until summer, which 29 begins at the end of June. During the spring, the 38 earth's axis is tilted toward the sun. 

Sandra Day O'Connor

Sandra Day O'Connor was born in 1930. She and her 10 family lived on a cattle ranch in Texas, where she 20 28 learned to work hard. After graduating from high 36 school. Sandra went to college at Stanford University. 45 She became a judge. She had many important positions 53 such as Attorney General of Arizona. In 1981, 61 President Ronald Reagan appointed Sandra to be a judge on the U.S. Supreme Court. She was the first 71 female Supreme Court Justice in history. For 24 79 87 years, she made decisions about the most important 96 cases in the country. She has written several books, 105 and sometimes still works as a substitute judge. Thank 114 you Sandra Day O'Connor for being the first female 119 on the U.S. Supreme Court!
